



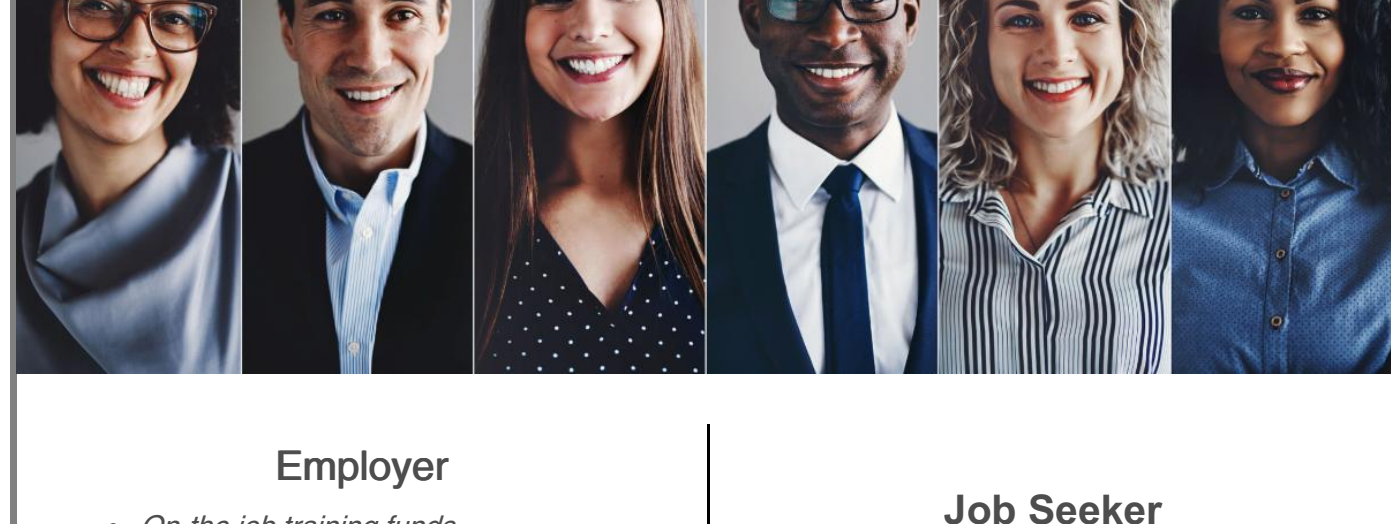

- Keep your composure
- Be clear and concise
- Good posture & stance
- Stay confident & positive

Present

- Dress for success
- Be on time
- Introduce yourself politely
- Be respectful to the interviewer(s)
- Bring a resume

Look at the interview as a conversation, but don't get too relaxed. It is a time for the employer to get to know you and an opportunity for you to better understand the employer. You will be asked several questions by the employer but you will also be given the opportunity to ask questions.
